Installing FreeBSD

FreeBSD is an open source operating similar to Linux. This presentation will cover the basics of installing Unix-like operating systems on Intel PC's using FreeBSD as a specific example. These issues include disk partitioning, file systems, and choosing core applications. A short discussion of the history of Unix and its open source variants will also be presented.

Professor Corbesero's lecture will be followed by an "install-fest" where you will be able to install FreeBSD, Linux, or other Unix-like operating systems on your own PC or laptop.

If you are interested in doing this, you must:
